

COVID Riding Rules

Phase 1- May 14, 2020

How Will We Keep You Safe?

- Perimeter gates will remain closed and locked when the facility is not open. They will be opened only on dates that are specified (please see the Team up calendar on our website).
- > At no time will there be more than 15 people allowed in the space (including staff)
- A minimum social distance of 6 feet must be maintained by everyone in the area at all times including when you are at the truck and trailer unit.
- ➤ We aim for a zero to low touch environment, therefore all surfaces including gates will be managed by **STAFF ONLY.** All touch areas will be sanitized by staff using an approved cleaning solution.
- > There are no washrooms available at this site.
- > During the use of the facility there will be no sharing of any props/tack/equipment etc.
- It is every individual's social responsibility to ensure their own and others safety. Therefore you are required to follow the social distancing guidelines outlined by the CMOH at all times. Staff reserves the right to refuse usage of the facility to anyone not practicing guidelines set out by the CMOH.
- Socializing with anyone outside of your household is discouraged while using the facility and must be done at the prescribed distance of the Chief Medical Officer of Health.

Additional Rules

- ➤ There will be no coaching, vetting, alternative therapies (i.e. massage), sale of livestock/tack or any other activities outside of recreational riding.
- When possible, horses should arrive saddled and leave saddled. This helps to move individuals through the space in a timely manner and decrease risk of contact.
- > Livestock can only be tied to the trailer that they were transported to the site in
- No spectators allowed.

How Do You Book a Time to Use the Facility?

At the time of booking, you must indicate how many people will be in your party as well as their names and contact information. This information is collected for the sole purpose of traceability and would be made available to the health inspector upon request. All bookings will only be taken by the booking agent via email stettleragsociety1907@gmail.com or by phone 403-742-6288. Bookings will only be accepted between the hours of 9 am and 5pm Monday- Friday. Bookings will not be taken via messenger or Facebook.

All riders will be logged into a riding log that will be maintained by the booking agent.
