COVID-19

 We are aware that COVID-19 has been a major challenge for agricultural societies

 Financial impacts from lost event revenue while continuing to incur fixed costs

Relaunch challenges



COVID-19 Agricultural Society Support

- Maintaining and expediting payment of the \$11.5 million agricultural society grant program
- Up to \$5,000 under Alberta's Small and Medium Enterprise Relaunch Grant
 - 37 had payment sent or pending; another 18 are draft or under review
- Supporting the Canadian Association of Fairs and Exhibitions' (CAFE) request to the federal government for \$74 million

Annual Returns

Due February 15, 2021

 Required to be in good standing under the Act, which is an eligibility requirement for the grant

No changes to form/process for 2021



Annual Return Checklist

Directors List
2020 Activities Report
Copy of the minutes of the most recent AGM
Opy of the minutes of the 2 nd most recent AGM (as adopted at the most recent AGM)
AGM membership sign-in sheet (to verify quorum was achieved)
Financial Statements
Must be approved at the annual general meeting by your membership
Must be signed by two directors of the agricultural society and the accountant
Must be a review engagement or audit report prepared by a professional accounting firm

Bylaws

Bylaws

 The new Agricultural Societies Regulation (2019) now specifies the requirements for bylaws going forward

 All societies have to review and update their bylaws by the end of the three-year transition period

 Seven have been approved under the new regulations (276 to go!)



Updating Bylaws

 You can keep using your current bylaws until June 30, 2022 (only two more AGM cycles to amend)

 Modernized legislation provides greater flexibility for organizational structure based on your unique needs

 You are free to keep your current organizational structure if you are happy with it



Bylaw support

- AAAS has updated their Recommended Best Practice Agricultural Society Bylaws template
 - 149 societies have now taken the workshop/webinar

- Agriculture and Forestry Checklist
 - We can review draft bylaws prior to your AGM if you give us sufficient lead time
 - If you haven't addressed all items on the first page of the checklist, we can't approve them



Bylaw Checklist

Membership Bylaws (Section 6 of Regulation)	List
	Section
Classes of membership & eligibility criteria	
Circumstances when sale of new memberships are suspended (e.g. when a special meeting is called until the	
business of the meeting is concluded; can also state there are no circumstances but must address in bylaws)	
Payment of membership fee & conditions of membership	
Manner and criteria for suspension or cancellation of membership	
Society Meetings Bylaws (Section 7 of Regulation)	
Method of notification of members and public (public must be notified of your AGM)	
Specify Items on Agenda for AGM	
Specify process of meeting to address serious concerns initiated by no fewer than 10 members	
Quorum Bylaws (Section 8 of Regulation)	
Quorum for a meeting of society	
Quorum for a board of directors meeting	
Voting Bylaws (Section 9 of Regulation)	
Govern the voting, including voting by proxy	



Code of Conduct

All societies must establish a Code of Conduct

- Required by the new Regulations (section 12)
 - Must include provisions respecting conflicts of interest
 - Directors and employees must sign

 Can reference this requirement in your bylaws, but don't recommend putting them in the bylaws
